Job Summary

A YLD Advisor is just that: a mentor who advises teens in the Youth Leadership program. Advisors guide discussions and activities that give participants the opportunity to share their thoughts, feelings, opinions and concerns, as well as to learn from peers, guest speakers, and training sessions. The purpose is to help youth build relationships and become positive role models in the community.

Requirements

- 20 years of age or older
- Experience with leadership programs or activities
- Be at least 5 minutes early for scheduled volunteer times
- Commitment of 2 hours per week on Wednesday evenings during the school year
- Must attend a YMCA Youth Leadership training evening
- Prepare weekly leadership activity sessions with co-advisor using manual provided
- Support youth with occasional special events for the community
- Completion of volunteer documentation with criminal record check
- First Aid certification an asset

- Commitment to organization vision and values: Demonstrates and promotes a personal understanding of and appreciation for the mission, vision, strategic outcomes and values of the YMCA
- Teamwork
- Relationship building and collaboration
- Planning and organizing
