Southwind:

What should my kids bring to camp?

Please send your campers dressed appropriately to participate in outdoor physical activities. We also request that they come prepared to get wet.

Does Southwind have a swimming pool?

Camp southwind does not have a swimming pool however we may be doing activities with water so we request campers come with a bathing suit and towel.

How old do my kids need to be to sleep over?

Campers 8 and older are invited to spend the night on Thursday night. We will be serving dinner breakfast and lunch for your campers.

How do I request my child be grouped with a friend?

If you have a friend request for camp southwind please email us with your request at southwind.requests@vanymca.org

General Camps:

What should my kids bring to camp?

An information package will be provided at registration detailing what your child will need to bring to camp.

How do I get more information about the week?

On day 1 staff will be handing out welcome to camp letters to all parents. These letters will include more detailed information on what to expect and hopefully answer most of your questions. If you still have questions a site supervisor is available to speak with at sign in and sign out times.

What do we need to bring with us for day 1 of camp?

We require all of our campers to complete a YMCA medical form. This form will be given to you or mailed to you upon registration and is also available at camp on day 1. We will not accept kids without a completed medical form.

Why do I need to bring photo ID everyday to sign out my child?

Photo ID checks are done in order to provide an extra step of safety for all campers.

Are your camps nut aware zone?

Yes, every effort is made to be nut aware. We ask that children do not come to camp with any food that contains nuts. There are many yummy alternatives out there!

To cancel your registration and receive a refund or letter of credit, notification must be received 7 days prior to the start date of program. A \$15 administration fee is charged on all refunds. In the event of a medical emergency, a full refund is issued upon receipt of a doctor's note.

There will be no refunds after the program has started.
